

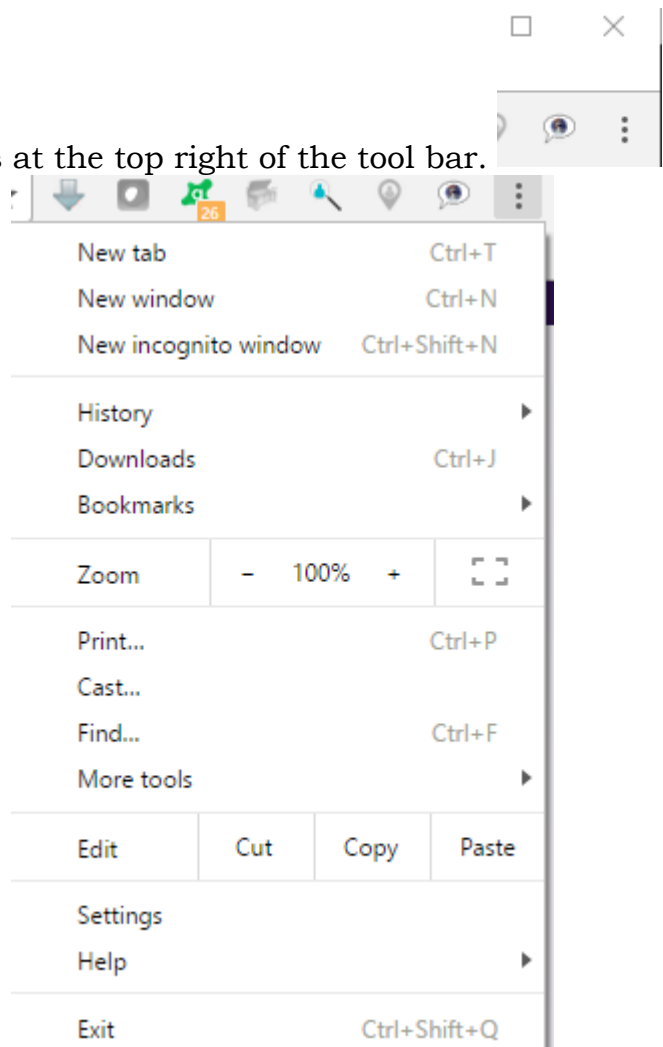
Setting up WoodenVillage Exceptions

Several websites would like to open up a new tab for their use or to allow the user to keep the primary web page available to go back to. ZRoots.org's links page (<http://www.zroots.org/links.html>) opens additional tabs for each of its links. If you are using WoodenVillage you will need to update both Chrome and FireFox browsers to allow an exception for WoodenVillage to create the pop-up tab.

WoodenVillage works in conjunction with FamilySearch.org and searches through your ancestor records to display "Record Hints", "Missing Parents", "Multiple Parents" and "Ordinances Needed" plus several other services. When WoodenVillage runs it wants to create a new tab to display your results. You will need to update both Chrome and FireFox to allow an exception for WoodenVillage to create the pop-up tab. This will allow your results to be easily printed or saved without all the intermediate data from checking your family history.

For Chrome follow these instructions.

1. Click on the vertical three dots at the top right of the tool bar.



2. Click on the Settings selection.

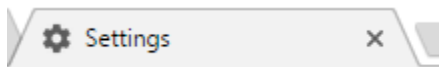

6. Click on the Manage exceptions... button.
7. Enter “woodenvillage.org:80” in the box and press the enter key. Now add zroots.org and press enter.

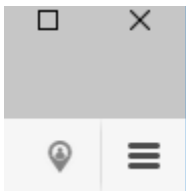


8. Press the Done button and close the dialog box.
9. Press the Done button on the next box. Then close the Settings tab and you are done.



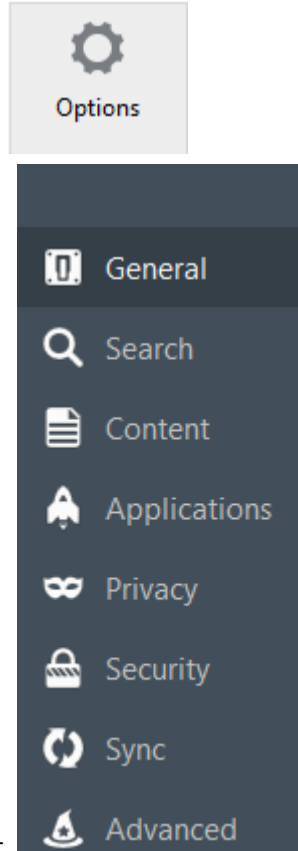
For FireFox follow these instructions.

1. Click on the three vertical bars on the top right of the tool bar.

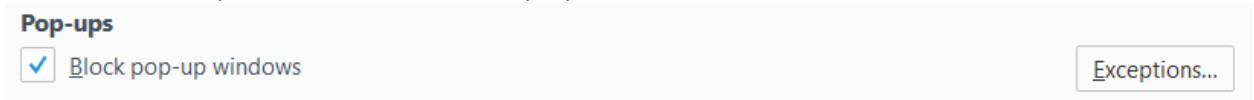

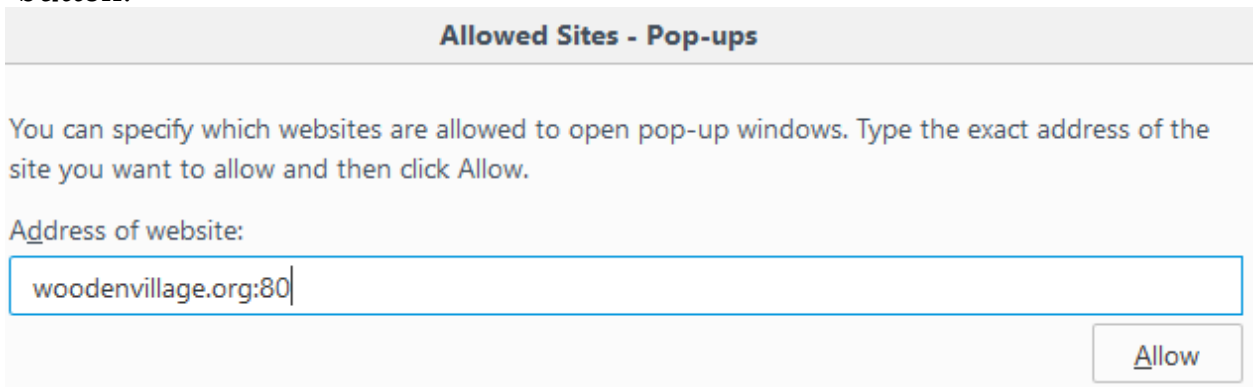
2. Click on the Options button in the drop down.



3. Click on the Content tab in the panel on the left.
4. Click on the Exceptions... button for the Pop-ups.

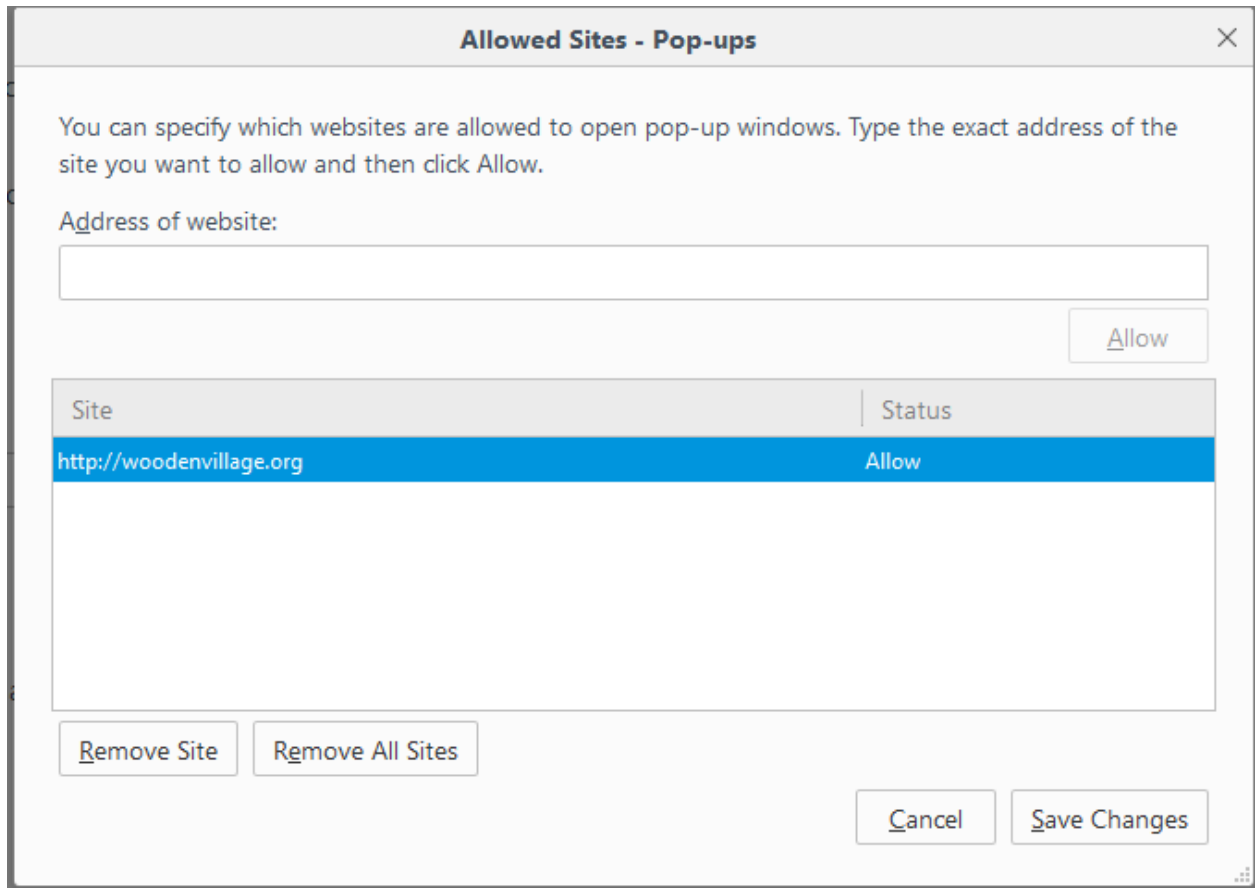


5. Enter “woodenvillage.org:80” in the Address line and press the Allow button.

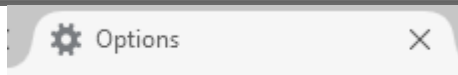


- Now add roots.org and press enter.
6. Click on “Save Changes” to close the dialog box.

For Microsoft Edge follow these instructions.

1. Microsoft Edge currently allow a new tab to be opened from a web window. No changes are needed.

For Apple Safari follow these instructions.

1. Apple Safari currently opens a new window for each link. No changes are needed.

For Opera follow these instructions.

1. Microsoft Edge currently allow a new tab to be opened from a web window. No changes are needed.
